FINLAND – A PIONEER IN BIOECONOMY

Finland's long-term objective is to become a carbon-neutral society. Within the next 10 years, Finland wants to be a pioneer in bioeconomy, circular economy and clean-tech. In the energy system wood fuels are already the largest energy source, and it is planned that their use will increase by 35 % by 2030. Many new biofuel and energy plants are planned.

MARKET DEVELOPMENT

The use of biomass for energy is increasing, but the development has not been steady nor even for different bioenergy sectors. Electricity and fossil fuel prices are currently low, which has become a barrier for wider use of energy-efficient combined heat and power production with biomass in some of the Nordic countries. Sustainability of biomass is also a hot topic with direct impacts on the market. Are biofuels a competitor or a companion to electric transport in the Nordic/Baltic region? Come and listen to the experts in the market, discuss with peers and make business!

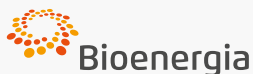
